Popular with residents and tourists alike, the Market has over 70,000 visitors a week on average.

Designated Sites

The Market Garden

A multi-functional space in the heart of Swansea Market. Primarily designed as a space for customers to eat, work and enjoy, The Market Garden can also be transformed into a space for live music, exhibitions, seasonal celebrations and mini markets.

Our bespoke casual trading area at the centre of Swansea Market is available for promotional lettings when not in use for trading. Situated near the popular cockle rotunda and fresh Welsh-cake stall, both serving traditional local delicacies, this unit has power and access to a sink as well as customisable chalk boards.
